Be at the course ready to play 5 minutes before your tee-time.

Tee-times and groups: I will be sending out, and posting on website, set tee-times for the first 7 weeks. I will redo groups for the 2nd 7 weeks, let me know if you have preferences not stated on your registration. Last 2 weeks of league championship you will be grouped with like standings in your flight for competition purposes.

Everyone tees off from white tee markers,

no matter where they are placed (I may move them up or back each week). If there are no white tee markers on #9, use the blue markers. If there are no tee markers at all on #9, you must tee off just to the front of the drainage line coming across the tee from the nursery.

"Winter rules" on your own fairway. This means you can roll your ball to improve your lie if necessary, in your own fairway only. Otherwise, play it as it lies.

New this year: In all traps, you are allowed to pick up your ball, rake, and replace.

Ground under repair (free drop): #9 - 2 abandoned bunkers left of fairway, #7 waste area short right of fairway, others with group consensus (let Greg know of other areas out there).

Be cognizant of YOUR pace of play. Keep up with the group in front of you. If you can't see them, then you need to make up some time.

MAXIMUM SCORE on any hole is

"quadruple bogey". Pick up and keep 'er movin'.

"Gimmes" are allowed "inside the leather" which is no more than 2 ft. An opponent must offer the "gimme".

All lost balls, unplayable lies, shots in the woods are lateral hazards. Drop near point of entry, 1 stroke penalty.

Scorekeeper: Adding all scores is optional but recommended to verify with player. Place card in black box in clubhouse before you leave. Text me an image of the scorecard if you forget.
